Privacy Policy

Broome Angling Society (The Society) has updated its privacy policy to comply with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) which became law in 2018. This is to give members more control regarding any data that The Society may hold about them.

General

The Society is a recreational angling club that is run by members for the benefit of other members so that they can carry out the recreational sport of angling on Society owned waters and on waters that the Society may lease.

The Society is a "not for profit" Society where members pay a membership fee annually to enable them to take part in angling. All funds collected from membership are used solely for the running of the club i.e. Maintenance, fish stocking, paying for waters that The Society may lease, purchasing new waters and general day to day running costs.

Membership

Membership details, i.e. names, addresses and phone numbers, as provided on the application form, are held on a standalone personal computer (PC) belonging to the Membership Secretary. The forms and any ID giving proof of age are shredded at the end of the season. Members also supply photos which are scanned onto the PC and then returned.

The data is used to send out The Society's newsletters, renewals and announcements. The photos are printed and attached inside the membership books as proof that the person is a member.

Only members of the Committee will have access to the data and solely for contacting members on matters about their membership. No other organisation or person, whether a member of the club or not, will be given any information about a member without their written permission. Unless required to by law.

If a member does not re-join the Society then his details will be retained for one season after leaving and then deleted. The data is backed up onto memory sticks, solely for the purpose of data recovery in the event a problem. Please contact the Membership Secretary with any queries.

Website

The Society operates a website. The website is for information and entertainment only.

The website is for the use of members and prospective members only but it is viewable to anyone on the internet.

The Society does not collect any Data on members except for that which is freely sent in by a member specifically to be published on the website and dealt with as specified below.

Competitions

The Society runs regular fishing competitions and the competition results are published on the website. The results are on the website for up to 18 months, when they are then deleted. If you do not want your name published on the website then please let the Match Secretary aware and they will not appear on the website.

Big Fish Competition

The Society runs a Big Fish Competition where members who catch a fish can enter it into the competition. We may hold photographs that have been submitted by entrants into the competition specifically to be published on the website for up to 18 months when they are then deleted. If you have entered the competition and sent in a photo you can have it removed at any time before the 18 months by making the webmaster aware.

Gallery Pages

The Society runs a Gallery page on the website for members to show photographs of themselves with any fish that they have caught and that they want to be put on the website. These pages will stay on the website as long as the sender remains a Society member. We will keep Gallery pages of members who have decided not to rejoin The Society on the website for up to 18 months in case they decide to rejoin at a later date. Members or former members who decide that they no longer want their

gallery page displayed can have it removed by making the webmaster aware.

News Pages

The Society runs a News Page on the website. This is to inform members of any upcoming events, announcements and items the membership may be interested in. Most of these items are sent in to the webmaster by the members themselves. If you do not want your name or any other personal data that you have included please make the webmaster aware and it will not be published. News items are on the website for up to 2 years. If an item that identifies you is on the website you may have it removed by contacting the webmaster.

Junior Pages

The Society runs a Junior Page on the website, for younger members. Any identifying content will only be published on the website with the written consent of the child's Parent or legal guardian. These pages will stay on the website as long as the sender remains a Society member. We will keep Gallery pages of Junior members who have decided not to rejoin The Society on the website for up to 18 months in case they decide to rejoin at a later date. Junior members or former junior members (or their parents/guardians) who decide that they no longer want their gallery page displayed can have it removed by making the webmaster aware.
